

Visit Boy Scout Jamboree with Troop 123

Who: Scouters and their families

What: Day visitors (**Observer Pass holders and Participant Pass holders**) have access to the Summit Center during the Jamboree. The Summit Center is the hub of Jamboree activity and is home to the stadium shows, the military exhibits, conservation trail, Disabilities Awareness Area, Sustainability Treehouse, merit badges, visit the main retail store, purchase retail food items, experience Brownsea Island, and a wide variety of other exhibits and displays. **{In addition, those who purchase a “Participant Pass” can experience other elements of the Summit Center including Boulder Cove, Challenge Course, Skate Board Plaza, Mountain Biking, Climbing, and BMX riding.}**

When: Thursday July 20 – Sunday July 23

Where: Bechtel Summit in West Virginia (4 hours away)

Why: Experience a taste of the Jamboree

Anticipated total cost of trip will be ~\$200 per person (this estimate is a total of camping fees, food fees, Jamboree pass fees. It just gives you an idea of what it may cost per person.)

Itinerary:

- Leave Worthington ~4pm Thursday
- Tent camp at ACE campground
- Check out the 2017 Jamboree Friday 9am – 5pm
- Check out the 2017 Jamboree Saturday 9am – end of show
- Depart ACE campground ~10am Sunday
- Return to Columbus ~3pm

Next Steps:

- Sign up with Angela Strous **by June 12**
- Notify Angela Strous of any dietary restrictions
- Pay Fees to the Troop
 - **Pay Camping fee**
 - Youth \$38 (for 3 nights of camping)
 - Adult \$48 (for 3 nights of camping)
 - **Pay \$12 camp food fee** (for 3 days of camping)
 - This fee covers 3 breakfasts, some snacks, 1 dinner, 2 cracker barrels
- Pay Food travel fee (*Applicable if parent will not be attending with their registered scout*)
 - \$10 down for fast food dinner
 - \$10 home for fast food lunch
 - *Scout will be given this money at the restaurant. The scout will keep any change left from their purchases.*
- Plan spending money for your youth

- Scouts will be responsible for purchasing the following meals on-site at the Jamboree.
 - Friday – Lunch
 - Saturday – Lunch, Dinner
- There will be vendors and merchants selling Jamboree patches, clothing, souvenirs

Notable information on Jamboree premises:

- No backpacks (Adults and older youth may bring a small daypack or string bag.)
- No Coolers
- No picnic baskets
- Shuttle transportation to the Summit Center from the visitor lot is provided with your pass.
- Upon arrival, all visitors will see a Youth Protection presentation.
- Under 6 years old free admission
- Ages 6-10 pay the youth fee
