This means that if you sell \$300.00 worth of popcorn, you earn about \$100.00 for you, plus this year you will also earn prizes. Again this year the popcorn is available NOW. You can take it with you to sell or deliver it quickly. Your customers will not have to wait to get their popcorn this year. Let's make this year, a record year selling popcorn.
