## Patrol Campout Duties

Job	Description
<b>Water / Fire</b>	Gets drinking and wash water. Prepares and builds Patrol fire. Cares for and prepares equipment used to cook on. Checks and fills Stove and lantern with fuel. Makes sure stove and lantern are in working order. Repairs as needed.
<b>Cook</b>	Prepares meals, washes kitchen utensils used for meal preparation. If cook burns food onto a pot or pan it is his responsibility to clean it.
<b>Assistant Cook</b>	Assists cook as requested, prepares pot of water for dish washing, and supervises meal cleanup.
<b>Meal Cleanup</b>	Cleans patrol pots and pans used in serving meal, properly stows patrol gear and food.

You may be asked to do additional duties as needed on the campout by your Patrol Leader, Senior Patrol Leader or Adult Leaders. Please cooperate.

All Patrol members are responsible for their own personal gear cleanup. It is not the duty of the Cleanup person to clean **your gear**.

Patrol gear is the responsibility of all the members of the Patrol. If it is lost, damaged or destroyed it is the responsibility of the Patrol to replace it. **Treat it like it was yours!**
